### **1. CV Creation Tips**

- Keep your CV 1–2 pages only.
- Start with a clear 2–3 line professional summary.
- Highlight technical skills first (HTML, CSS, JS, React, WordPress, Node.js, SQL).
- Add a Projects Section with live URLs and GitHub links.
- Include freelance or internship experience.
- Use bullet points instead of paragraphs.
- Show achievements: e.g., 'Improved page speed from 55% to 90%'.
- Mention tools: Figma, GitHub, VS Code, Postman, cPanel.
- Proofread — no grammar or spelling mistakes.
- Always save and send as PDF.

### **2. Portfolio Tips**

- Create a personal portfolio website.
- Add 3–5 projects with live links and GitHub code.
- Include: WordPress business site, React project, E-commerce sample site.
- Show before/after improvements if available.
- Project ideas: restaurant website, portfolio site, landing page, e-commerce, dashboard UI, weather app.

### **3. Interview Tips**

- Prepare for basic HTML/CSS/JS questions.
- Explain your projects clearly.

- Show problem-solving mindset.
- Ask one question at the end: 'Do you follow any code review process?'
- Be confident about learning new things quickly.

#### **4. Job Search Tips (Qatar Specific)**

- Search daily on LinkedIn, Indeed Qatar, NaukriGulf, Bayt.
- Check Qatar WhatsApp job groups and FB groups.
- Apply directly to digital agencies and startups.
- Use email + portfolio link when contacting companies.
- Attend tech meetups, workshops, networking events.

#### **5. Skills to Stand Out in Qatar**

- Hosting and deployment knowledge (cPanel, DNS).
- Elementor / Divi (for WordPress).
- SEO basics and on-page optimization.
- Deploying to Hostinger, Godaddy, Vercel.
